

III. SWIMMING POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All members and guests swimming or sunning must register at the check-in desk.
2. Each member must sign-in their guests when they arrive. No member may bring more than two guests to the pool at one time without approval of the Club Management. An out-of-town guest **MUST** be registered in the office by an adult member **ONLY** and receive a guest card. Guest fee is \$5.00 per guest. No charge for out-of-town guests. Guests must be accompanied by a Club member or show a guest card.
3. Children age twelve (12) years and older may swim unattended, provided the parents feel such children are responsible and mature enough to care for themselves. When children are by themselves they or the parent must write an emergency contact phone number on the sign-in sheet. Children under twelve (12) years of age must be accompanied by an adult member or babysitter.
4. Wading pool privileges shall follow the same hours as the swimming pool. Children over five (5) years of age are not allowed to go in the wading pool. Baby carriages, scooters, play pens and other similar items are not permitted. Adults and babysitters caring for children using this area **MUST** be present and in constant attendance.
5. There will be **POSITIVELY NO SMOKING OR LOITERING** in the pool restrooms.
6. Persons in pool attire must restrict their presence to the pool area.
7. Towels will be provided by the Club. All guests and members must check their towels out when they get one and check it back in when they leave. If the towel is not turned back in, the member will be charged \$5.00 per towel.
8. No pets of any kind shall be permitted in the pool area.
9. Swimming parties must be arranged with the Director of Catering.
10. There is to be **NO RUNNING AROUND POOL AREA, UNNECESSARY ROUGHNESS OR BOISTEROUS PLAY AT ANY TIME.**
11. Lifeguards and Club Management have the authority to expel from the pool area any person who fails to comply with the above rules. There will be two (2) warnings given, then the parents will be called or talked to.
12. Please help keep the pool area clean! Please dispose of food, paper items and beverage containers in receptacles which are conveniently located. Eating around the pool is restricted to the designated areas.
